- **Book:** *The Wheels on the Tuk Tuk* (Everybody who is still up front do the motions with me 😊)
- **Magnet board or felt board story:** A Nest in Springtime (Kai read Chinese & Kelly read English & do felt board)
- **Book/Puppet Theater:** *Spicy Hot Colors* (Lucia reads, puppets cavort 😊)
- **Fingerplays/Songs:** Frere Jacques (Let's try to do a round!) (Maybe!) (Didn't! But it sounded great with the guitar!)
- **Special Book/Puppet Theater:** *Catch That Goat!* (Anna & Adelle puppeteers, Kelly narrate and show book)
